


Number of Children Referred and Authorized for EI Services,* July 2008 - March 2011

Cumulative Number of Active Children by Fiscal Year* July 2006 - March 2011



- The number of children authorized for services through Q3, FY 2011 dropped by 14% compared to the same period of the prior fiscal year (32,722 vs. 38,232).


Proportion of New Referrals by Age at Time of Referral, July 2007 - March 2011
