

CHAPTER 4.L

VISUAL RESOURCES

This section assesses the potential impacts of the *Mosquito Population Control Program in the Rockaways* on visual resources, which are an area's unique or important public view corridors, vistas, or natural or built features. Visual impacts would include the blocking of a significant view or resource, changes to an urban design feature so that a natural or built visual resource is no longer dominant in an area, or changes to an urban design feature so that the context of a visual resource is altered.

No permanent structures would be created as a result of the population-control activities, and the application would occur principally by truck. The only visual changes that would occur would be trucks passing through neighborhoods during periods of application. Therefore, the *Mosquito Population Control Program in the Rockaways* activities would not result in any significant adverse impacts on visual resources.
