



# BULK COLLECTION SCHEDULE CHANGES

QUEENS: COMMUNITY BOARD 10

To accommodate collection of oversized, non-recyclable items in Queens District 10, DSNY is updating its bulk collection schedule. This affects the Hamilton Beach, Howard Beach, Lindenwood, South Ozone Park, Ozone Park and South Richmond Hill neighborhoods.

Set out oversized, non-recyclable items after 4pm the night before your last collection day each week and DSNY will collect these items by Saturday evening. This change affects non-recyclable items larger than 4 feet by 3 feet, such as mattresses and couches.

## RECYCLE METAL AND PLASTIC ITEMS

Place out items made mainly of metal and/or rigid plastic after 4pm the night before your recycling day.

## HELPFUL REMINDERS

- Non-recyclable items smaller than 4 feet by 3 feet can be set out on any garbage collection day.
- Because of the Asian long-horned beetle quarantine, DSNY cannot accept tree limbs or branches. Instead, visit the NYC Department of Parks & Recreation at [nyc.gov/parks](https://nyc.gov/parks) or call 3-1-1 for free chipping and disposal.
- For collection of appliances, call 3-1-1 to schedule a CFC/Freon recovery appointment.
- For set out requirements for mattresses, call 3-1-1 or visit [nyc.gov/dsny](https://nyc.gov/dsny).
