<b>Background on Project:</b>  NYC Emergency Management's Emergency Operations Center (EOC) Unit oversees the running of the EOC, as a central location for senior officials from City, State, and federal agencies, nonprofits, private sector, regional and utilities partners to work during emergencies in order to lessen the impacts of emergencies and handle recovery issues. The EOC Unit seeks an intern to assist in several projects that support NYC Emergency Management's capacity to coordinate response to large emergencies and learn from responses of prior incidents.	
<b>Description of Project/Intern Responsibilities:</b>  The EOC Intern will use NYC Emergency Management's existing plans, protocols, and after-action reports to create and update Emergency Support Function (ESF) Guides for ESF Coordinators to use during emergency activations. An ESF is a group of agencies and organizations that coordinate response to specific effects of an emergency on a service or system (e.g., mass care and human services, public health and medical services, transportation systems, etc.). The EOC Intern will also identify best practices for documenting feedback from debriefs with emergency responders, provide EOC facility support, and assist in developing evaluation materials for NYC Emergency Management's drills and exercises, in addition to other projects that support the EOC Unit.
