<b>Description of Project/Intern Responsibilities:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Conduct emergency preparedness presentations to children attending public/private schools, summer camps, and after school programs (assemblies and workshops)</li><li>• Present at venues throughout the five boroughs. <u>Transportation expenses will not be reimbursed.</u></li><li>• Assist with program evaluation and development of new presentation tools.</li><li>• Attend monthly meetings for program and agency updates and evaluation.</li></ul>
