

**RULE CHANGES TO COMMERCIAL FLEET VIOLATIONS PROGRAMS****1. Which Commercial Vehicle Programs are affected by the recent changes?**

Commercial vehicles enrolled in the Fleet Program and the Stipulated Fine Program are affected by the recent changes.

**2. What are the new penalty charges?**

- Vehicles in the Fleet Program will be charged a \$10 penalty for each ticket that has not been paid or adjudicated within 45 days. After 90 days, an additional \$20 penalty will be added. After 135 days, an additional \$30 will be added. After 180 days, a default judgment will be entered against the ticket.
- Vehicles in the Stipulated Fine Program will lose any abatement on tickets that are not resolved within 45 days.

**3. What is a Judgment?**

Judgment means that the City can take steps to collect debt such as sending your debt to a collection agency or seizing assets.

**4. Can my vehicle be booted or towed?**

Yes! If you have more than \$350 of tickets in judgment, your vehicle can be booted or towed.

**5. When do these changes go into effect?**

The penalty changes went into effect on March 6, 2014. You will begin to see these changes on your statements and when you log onto the Fleet/Rental Online system in April 2014.
