

Come talk to us about your Notice of Property Value!

In February 2017, the NYC Department of Finance and NYC Tax Commission will hold NOPV events in all five boroughs. These are open to anyone. At these events you can:

- Speak one-on-one with someone from the Department of Finance or the Tax Commission to discuss your property
- Ask questions about your property's Market Value, Assessed Value and Transitional Assessed Value
- Learn how to dispute your property's Assessed Value
- Learn how to get your property description changed (for example, the number of units in your building or square footage)
- Learn about exemptions and how to apply for them
