Q&A**

- 1. Does this RFP call for the responder to provide Broadband services as well?**
 - No. Broadband service will be provided through other, coordinated initiatives.

- 2. If so – where would the broadband be located? Would you be looking for broadband connections in each apt or a central point? Or would the Wi-Fi be the broadband medium?**
 - This is not a request for Wi-Fi service or any other broadband service solution. A proposal that includes providing devices that residents can use to access Wi-Fi service can assume the Wi-Fi service will be available everywhere on NYCHA property at these developments.

- 3. Regarding the Wi-Fi component – can the vendor respond with a Wi-Fi solution but not provide the end-user device? Is The Mayor's Fund/NYCHA looking for a centralized Wi-Fi system? Could a hybrid solution be employed? Are you looking for Wi-Fi components in each apartment, floor, common area, etc.?**
 - No. This is not a request for Wi-Fi service or any other broadband service solution. A proposal can include providing devices that residents can use to access Wi-Fi service, which will be provided through other, coordinated initiatives.
