Procurement Description:

The Department of Homeless Services (DHS) is seeking an appropriately qualified vendor to operate a 200 bed substance abuse treatment shelter for homeless men at the 8 East 3rd St shelter facility located at 8 East 3rd St, New York, NY 10003. The description for this site is listed below in Section 1, B. Site Profile. The contractor selected through this RFP will provide the services in accordance with New York State Codes, Rules and Regulations, Title 18, Part 491 (18 NYCRR 491), DHS policies and procedures, and related court decrees.

DHS' overall goals and objectives with respect to this procurement are to develop and refine its programming to engage and motivate clients and to encourage participation that will enable clients to achieve independent living outside the shelter system.

DHS considers shelters to be time-limited, emergency facilities for persons who have no other place to live. In addition to providing safe and cost-effective room and board, shelter programs must assist clients to return to living independently in the community. Through this RFP, DHS wishes to identify a provider who, in partnership with DHS, will excel at achieving these goals.

Providers must have a 501c3 IRS Determination letter to be eligible to propose.
