Procurement Description:

The New York City Department of Correction (DOC or the Department) is seeking up to four qualified vendors for the Individualized Corrections Achievement Network (I-CAN) program to provide skill-building and discharge preparation services to eligible pretrial and sentenced, male and female inmates, during their incarceration in city jails and after their release in community-based settings in the boroughs. The Department welcomes up to four proposals per proposer and innovative approaches including team proposals.

Contractors will target DOC-identified inmates who are at moderate to high risk for readmission and provide them with evidence-based services that will promote jail safety and reduce likelihood of readmission. I-CAN will serve 6400 participants per year, with each contract covering 1600 individuals. The target population will be referred to the Contractor(s) for comprehensive pre and post release services offered seven days per week. Monday through Friday, jail-based facilitators will each run two daily 2.5 hour sessions with about 25 participants in each group. Weekend programming will consist of a variety of activities which may include: arts and crafts, physical training, health and wellness activities, book clubs & discussions, interactive journaling, and additional hard skills workshops.
