Procurement Title: Family Center Services – Bronx

### Procurement Description:

The Emergency Housing Services (“EHS”) program of the Department of Housing Preservation and Development (“HPD”) of the City of New York (“City”) provides temporary housing to families and individuals who have been displaced from their homes as a result of fires and city-issued vacate orders for health and safety. Temporary housing is available commencing on the day of the issuance of the order. The Family Center Services program provides temporary shelter facilities to families with children in the boroughs of Manhattan, Brooklyn and the Bronx for families in need of shelter due to such displacement. This RFP is for services in the Bronx, only.

Through this procurement, HPD will seek an appropriately qualified Family Center provider who will provide temporary shelters and rehousing assistance, and manage them according to Rules of the City of New York, Title 28, Chapter 18, (see Attachment G). The proposed Family Center facility should have the capacity to house a minimum of 185 people. HPD anticipates award of one contract resulting from this RFP, sufficient to ensure the appropriate service level for the City. Even though the site will be in the Bronx, the contract awarded will be for citywide services.
