Procurement Title: Provision of Supportive Housing for Homeless and At-Risk Persons

HRA is seeking qualified contractors to provide scattered-site supportive housing along with appropriate supportive services to eligible persons as defined below. The procurement of 500 scattered site units is for immediate occupancy. The contractor will work with all eligible clients. Services provided by the program will allow the clients to live full, healthy, independent lives.

Procurement Description: The populations targeted for this procurement are:

1. Chronically homeless single adults with a serious mental illness or with a mental illness and a co-occurring substance use disorder.
2. Chronically homeless families, or families at serious risk of becoming chronically homeless, in which the head of the household has a serious mental illness, a substance use disorder, a disabling medical condition or HIV/AIDS .
3. Young adults (aged 18-25 years) leaving or having recently left foster care or who have been in foster care for more than one year after their 16th birthday and who are homeless or at-risk of street or sheltered homelessness.

Concept Report Link: Supportive housing combines affordable housing with appropriate social services to help special populations that are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless achieve housing stability and independence in the community. It is a proven solution to homelessness for individuals and families with special needs, and less costly and more appropriate than expending resources on institutional and temporary settings such as shelters, hospitals, jails and prisons.
