ONE NEW YORK: WORKING FOR OUR NEIGHBORHOODS MOBILE PAY FOR PARKING METERS

By the end of this year New Yorkers will be able to use their cell phones to pay for parking at any of the City's 85,000 metered spaces.

Details

- The technology will enable drivers to save time by skipping the cash payment and receipt process at Muni-Meters. The pay-by-phone option will also allow a user to remotely add time to a car's parking space.
- Muni-Meters will continue to accept coins, NYC Parking Cards and credit cards.
- New tablet devices will allow parking enforcement agents to immediately determine whether a parked car is paid up.
- The app is being developed by the Department of Transportation and will be available this summer.
- The citywide initiative is the result of a successful pilot program in the Belmont neighborhood of the Bronx.
