

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

Question 1. We are completing the budget for the NY/NY III proposal and have a question for which I have been unable to find guidance in the RFP. Are we correct in assuming that HASA will pay rents directly to us for their clients who receive rental assistance? And that we will collect the rent share from clients who receive SSI?

Answer: Rent is provided through the NY/NY III contract as a line item. Providers should only be collecting rent from clients with SSI/SSD or other income using the 30% formula. This amount is used as an offset.
