Notes from Frances Pardus-Abbadessa, Executive Deputy Commissioner HRA/OCSE:

The total collections received for the month of January was \$49.8 million. Although collections for Former increased by 59% compared to January 2012, it is due to the fact that the State carried out a one-time cleanup project in 2012 with the Department of Health to identify cases that received Medicaid at any time and moved them from Never to Former. PEP has reached 74.28% a modest increase over December, yet it is the highest level ever recorded. SEP continues to remain steady at 70%.

⁽¹⁾ This measure includes actively charging and arrears only cases. However, if we consider only actively charging cases (cases with an ongoing obligation) this percentage increases to 56%
