Notes from Frances Pardus-Abbadessa, Executive Deputy Commissioner HRA/OCSE:

OCSE collected \$53.9 million in February. This is an increase of 8.1% over January 2013 which was also a four week month. Total Cases with Orders increased by 1.5% and New Orders increased by 31.2% compared to February of last year. PEP remains at its new high of 74% and SEP continues to remain stable at 70%.

⁽¹⁾ This measure includes actively charging and arrears only cases. However, if we consider only actively charging cases (cases with an ongoing obligation) this percentage increases to 58 %
