Notes from Frances Pardus-Abbadessa, Executive Deputy Commissioner HRA/OCSE:

OCSE collected \$76.1 million in March 2013 (a five week month). This is an increase of 41.3% over February 2013 (a four week month). PEP reached its highest level ever recorded at 74.33%. SEP continues to remain stable at 70%. Cases with a collection in the month (which includes actively charging and arrears only cases) reached 44%, its highest level since June 2012. This means more families are receiving Child Support. Total New Orders rose to 1,942, a plus of 38% over prior month, exceeding the old record of 1,750 from March 2005.

⁽¹⁾ This measure includes actively charging and arrears only cases. However, if we consider only actively charging cases (cases with an ongoing obligation) the Total Cases with a Collection percentage increases to **61%**.

⁽²⁾ The State carried out a one-time clean up project in 2012 with the Department of Health to identify cases that received Medicaid at any time and moved them from Never to Former.
