Notes from Frances Pardus-Abbadessa, Executive Deputy Commissioner HRA/OCSE:

OCSE collected \$55.2 million Child Support in July 2013, an 0.2% increase compared to July 2012. SEP remains stable at 70.2% and PEP reached a new all-time high of 74.88%. CYTD New Orders rose by 28% compared to CYTD 2012. The amount of Support Due decreased significantly in July due to an effort to close account level cases that were appropriate for closure. This contributed to the large decrease in the percentage of "Current Distributed – Former."

*= 5 week month

⁽¹⁾ This measure includes actively charging and arrears only cases. However, if we consider only actively charging cases (cases with an ongoing obligation) the Total Cases with a Collection percentage increases to 60% this month.

⁽²⁾ The State carried out a one-time clean up project in 2012 with the Department of Health to identify cases that received Medicaid at any time and moved them from Never to Former.
