Notes from Frances Pardus-Abbadessa, Executive Deputy Commissioner HRA/OCSE:

In August 2013, OCSE collected \$68.3 million in Child Support, averaging \$13.7 million a week. PEP reached a record high of 76% and met its CY13 goal. SEP grew to 71.5%, its highest level since March 2006. We continue do well in establishing new orders. We obtained 1,870 new orders, the second highest number ever recorded. We still observe the effects of ongoing cleanup projects aiming at closing account level cases that are appropriate for closure. This contributes to the large decrease in Current Support Due and in the percentage of "Current Distributed – Former."

⁽¹⁾ This measure includes actively charging and arrears only cases. However, if we consider only actively charging cases (cases with an ongoing obligation) the Total Cases with a Collection percentage increases to 59% this month.

⁽²⁾ The State carried out a one-time clean up project in 2012 with the Department of Health to identify cases that received Medicaid at any time and moved them from Never to Former.
