Notes from Frances Pardus-Abbadessa, Executive Deputy Commissioner HRA/OCSE:

OCSE collected 63.5 million in April 2014 (a four week month). This was the second highest collection in a four week month in history; surpassed only by April 2013, when OCSE collected 65 million. 71.3% of the caseload has a child support order; exceeding 71% for a ninth month in a row. PEP continues its upward trend: 76.52% of children born out of wedlock had their paternity established – a new record. Current support distributed is 84% in April 2014, a 10% increase over prior month. The number of New Orders rose to 1,752, a plus of 4% over prior month.

⁽¹⁾ This measure includes actively charging and arrears only cases. However, if we consider only actively charging cases (cases with an ongoing obligation) the Total Cases with a Collection percentage increases to 59% this month.

⁽²⁾ We continue to observe the effects of ongoing cleanup projects aiming at closing account level cases that are appropriate for closure. This contributes to the large decrease in Current Support Due and in the percentage of "Current Distributed – Former."

⁽³⁾ The State carried out a one-time clean up project in 2012 with the Department of Health to identify cases that received Medicaid at any time and moved the collection data from Never to Former, leaving the cases in place.
