Notes from Frances Pardus-Abbadessa, Executive Deputy Commissioner HRA/OCSE:

Collections received for the month of May 2014 (a five week month) totaled \$75.9 million. This is a 19.66% increase over April 2014 (a four week month), and a 5.17% increase over May 2013 (a five week month). CYTD collections increased by 1% compared to last year. SEP continues to exceed 71%: in May 2014, 71.43% of the caseload had a child support order. PEP's monthly growth persists: 76.78% of children born out of wedlock had their paternity established – it is the highest percentage ever recorded. New Orders set a new record as well, they reached an all-time high of 2,452, representing an increase of 40% over prior month and an increase of 32% over May 2013.

⁽¹⁾ This measure includes actively charging and arrears only cases. However, if we consider only actively charging cases (cases with an ongoing obligation) the Total Cases with a Collection percentage increases to 61% this month.

⁽²⁾ We continue to observe the effects of ongoing cleanup projects aiming at closing account level cases that are appropriate for closure. This contributes to the large decrease in Current Support Due and in the percentage of "Current Distributed – Former."

⁽³⁾ The State carried out a one-time clean up project in 2012 with the Department of Health to identify cases that received Medicaid at any time and moved the collection data from Never to Former, leaving the cases in place.
