Notes from Frances Pardus-Abbadessa, Executive Deputy Commissioner HRA/OCSE:

OCSE collected \$54,495,877 in the month of September (a four week month). This brings the calendar year to date total to \$556m which is equal to 75% of the 2014 collections goal (\$746m). In September OCSE saw the results of ongoing case clean up efforts which resulted in a 1.7% increase in SEP which is now at 73.06%. PEP continues to reach record highs at 78.60% which exceeds the 2014 goal by 2.6% this month. New orders year to date continue to show a 13% increase compared to 2013 with CA and Former cases leading with increases of 39% and 27% respectively. The percent of cases with a payment remains stable at 41%, but if we only consider cases with an ongoing obligation 58% had a payment in September.

⁽¹⁾ This measure includes actively charging and arrears only cases.

⁽²⁾ We continue to observe the effects of ongoing cleanup projects aiming at closing account level cases that are appropriate for closure. This contributes to the large decrease in Current Support Due and in the percentage of "Current Distributed – Former."

⁽³⁾ The State carried out a one-time clean up project in 2012 with the Department of Health to identify cases that received Medicaid at any time and moved the collection data from Never to Former, leaving the cases in place.
