Notes from Frances Pardus-Abbadessa, Executive Deputy Commissioner HRA/OCSE:

Collections received for the month of October 2014 (a five week month) totaled \$68,988,354, with the average collections per week increasing by 1.27% compared to last month. To date, OCSE collected 84% of the 2014 Goal which brings calendar year to date collections to \$625 million. SEP is at 72.9% for October, its second highest level since 2010. The increase is attributable to a special case closure initiative. PEP continues to exceed the 2014 Goal at 78.46%. New orders remain high, achieving 1,980, the third highest ever recorded in a month. The percent of cases with a payment remains stable at 43%; however, if we examine cases with an ongoing obligation, 60% of the cases had a payment in October.

⁽¹⁾ This measure includes actively charging and arrears only cases.

⁽²⁾ We continue to observe the effects of ongoing cleanup projects aiming at closing account level cases that are appropriate for closure. This contributes to the large decrease in Current Support Due and in the percentage of "Current Distributed – Former."

⁽³⁾ The State carried out a one-time clean up project in 2012 with the Department of Health to identify cases that received Medicaid at any time and moved the collection data from Never to Former, leaving the cases in place.
