Notes from Frances Pardus-Abbadessa, Executive Deputy Commissioner HRA/OCSE:

OCSE Collected \$56.1 million for the month of September, averaging \$14 million per week. Total calendar year to date collections (Jan-Sept) have reached \$566m which is a 1.79% increase over the same period in 2014. Paternity Establishment Percentage (PEP) remains high reaching 79.39% and Support Establishment Percentage (SEP) remains stable at 72.99%. Cases with a collection in the month (which includes actively charging and arrears only cases) remains steady at 42%, but if we consider only actively charging cases with an ongoing obligation, 58% received a payment.

⁽¹⁾ This measure includes actively charging and arrears only cases.

⁽²⁾ We continue to observe the effects of ongoing cleanup projects aiming at closing account level cases that are appropriate for closure. This contributes to the large decrease in Current Support Due and in the percentage of "Current Distributed – Former."

⁽³⁾ The State carried out a one-time clean up project in 2012 with the Department of Health to identify cases that received Medicaid at any time and moved the collection data from Never to Former, leaving the cases in place.
