

Documents to Bring for ActionHealthNYC

- Any immigration records or letters from the government related to your citizenship or immigration status.
- Proof of income:
 - Paycheck stubs
 - Letter from employer
 - Current signed and dated tax returns
 - W-2 or 1099 tax forms
 - Worker's compensation documents
 - Child support information, including letter from court or person providing support
- Proof of identity:
 - IDNYC
 - Foreign passport
 - Consular ID
 - Marriage certificate or divorce decree
 - School ID card with photo
 - Employer ID card
 - Official diplomas or high school equivalency
 - I-94 Arrival Departure Record
 - I-797 Notice of Action
 - Immigrant Visa or Green Card
 - Refugee Travel Document
 - Employment Authorization Document
 - Immigration Court Orders
 - A letter from the ORR stating that you are a trafficking victim
 - U.S. Passport, or other federal identification
 - U.S. State driver's license
 - Certificate of Naturalization (N-550 or N-570) or Certificate of U.S. Citizenship (N-560 or N-561)
 - Social Security card
 - Hospital or clinic record

- Doctor's record
- If you have no proof of identity, you must fill out and sign an Attestation of Identity Form (DOH-5090).
