Immigration Update for Palestinians

Palestinians who were in the U.S. on February 14, 2024 may now begin applying for work permits.

Who is Eligible?

Non-US Citizens who are Palestinian and were present in the U.S. on February 14, 2024, qualify for deferred enforced departure with the **exception** of those who:

- Voluntarily returned to Palestinian territory after February 14, 2024,
- Have not continuously lived in the US since February 14, 2024.





Palestinians applying for a work permit will need to file Form I-765 and will need to provide



documents to prove their identity and nationality



a statement outlining the basis of their claim that they are covered by DED and evidence to support their claim



evidence proving they entered the U.S. and have been living in the U.S. prior to February 14, 2024.

Electronic Filing is **NOT** available for this type of work permit applications.

The filing fee for this application is \$520 but **fee waivers are available.**

BEWARE OF LEGAL IMMIGRATION SCAMS AND FRAUDULENT ACTORS

Remember:

- Only a licensed attorney or a DOJ Accredited Representative can file applications on your behalf.
- A public notary who is not a licensed attorney is unable to fill out these forms/file them on your behalf. They also cannot charge you to do this.



Immigration law is complicated. Beware of immigration legal scams or fraudulent providers who may indicate otherwise and make false promises, such as:

- A way to get a work permit or visa **immediately**.
- Statements indicating that there are **no risks or consequences**.
- Claims of **special influence** with immigration authorities.
