Under general supervision, he/she will be fully responsible for managing complex electrical trade work, lighting, power, prison security systems, and HVAC control systems, fire alarm or other construction projects from kickoff to closeout. .</p> <p>Among other duties, the candidate selected will manage submissions; schedule and run job meetings; ensure that contractors obtain required permits and approvals; approve contractors' coordinated schedule and track progress; identify problems with installation or quality and seek appropriate resolution; maintain contract files and written record of job progress; ensure the formulation then completion of punch list; and effectively manage project completion and closeout, including obtaining, filing and distributing all closeout documents.</p>
