<b>Job Description</b>	
Under direct supervision, the Electrician's Helper assists an Electrician in installing, repairing, replacing and maintaining electric wiring systems, appliances, apparatus and equipment according to the provisions of the New York City Electrical Code and approved plans and specifications; assists electricians in pulling wires and testing electrical systems; replaces defective light switches, plugs and lighting fixtures; checks signal systems; keeps electricians supplied with materials, tools and supplies; cleans working areas, machines, tools and equipment; performs routine machine operations; may operate motor vehicles or equipment in the performance of assigned duties; and perform related duties as required.	
<b>Minimum Qualification Requirements</b>	
1. Three years of full-time satisfactory experience acquired within the last 15 years as an electrician's helper or apprentice electrician; or 2. At least one and one-half years of full-time satisfactory experience as described in "1" above plus sufficient training of a relevant nature acquired in an approved trade or vocational high school to make up the equivalent of three years of acceptable experience. Six months of acceptable experience will be credited for each year of approved trade or vocational high school.	
<b>License Requirements</b>	
At the time of appointment to certain City agencies candidates will be required to possess a Motor Vehicle Driver License valid in the State of New York. This license must be maintained for the duration of the employment.	
<b>Residency Requirement</b>	
New York City residency is generally required within 90 days of appointment. However, City Employees in certain titles who have worked for the City for 2 continuous years may also be eligible to reside in Nassau, Suffolk, Putnam, Westchester, Rockland, or Orange County. To determine if the residency requirement applies to you, please discuss with the agency representative at the time of interview.
