Job Description	
<p>The New York City Department of Corrections (DOC) is one of the largest municipal jail systems in the United States. It provides for the care, custody, and control of persons accused of crimes or convicted and sentenced to one-year or less of jail time. The DOC operates 12 inmate facilities, nine of which are located on Rikers Island. In addition, the department operates two hospital prison wards (Bellevue and Elmhurst hospitals) and court holding facilities in Criminal, Supreme, and Family Court in each borough.</p> <p>The candidate recruited will serve as a Junior Java Developer in the Information Technology Division and will be work with a team to deliver application systems, provide production support for existing web applications, create technical design documents with assistance from senior developers, and work with a development team on Java and J2EE software projects. The successful candidate will have the opportunity to contribute to the evolution of the system's architecture and technology, as well as the continual improvement of development processes.</p> <p>The candidate should possess 1+ years in designing and building applications with Object-Oriented software development methodologies and practices using JAVA and related technologies.</p>	
Minimum Qualification Requirements	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A baccalaureate degree from an accredited college, including or supplemented by 24 semester credits in computer science or a related computer field and two years of satisfactory full-time computer software experience in computer systems development and analysis, applications programming, database administration, maintenance and support, systems programming, data communications, mainframe development, mobile development, web development and design, including one year in a project leader capacity or as a major contributor on a complex project; or 2. A four-year high school diploma or its educational equivalent and six years of satisfactory full-time computer software experience as described in "1" above, including one year in a project leader capacity or as a major contributor on a complex project; or 3. Education and/or experience equivalent to "1" or "2" above. College education may be substituted for up to two years of the required experience in "2" above on the basis that 60 semester credits from an accredited college is equated to one year of experience. A masters degree in computer science or a related computer field, or a certificate of at least 625 hours in computer programming from an accredited technical school (post high school), may be substituted for one year of the required experience in "1" or "2" above. However, all candidates must have at least a four-year high school diploma or its educational equivalent and at least one year of satisfactory full-time experience in a project leader capacity or as a major contributor on a complex project.
