<p>The New York City Department of Correction has an opportunity for (4) Roofers. Under supervision, the qualified candidates will repair and maintain roofs composed of tar, gravel, slate, rubberoid, tin, copper, and galvanized metal; cut roofing paper, asphalt shingles and other roofing materials to fit roof corners, pipes and other objects; replace asphalt and slate shingles; repair skylights, ventilators, gutters, valleys, flashings and ridges; performs related work.</p>	
<b>Minimum Qualification Requirements</b>	
<p>1. Five years of full-time satisfactory experience as a Carpenter acquired within the last 10 years; or 2. Three years of experience as described in 1" above, plus sufficient training of a relevant nature acquired in an approved trade or vocational high school to make up a total of five years of acceptable experience. Six months of acceptable experience will be credited for each year of approved trade or vocational school training.</p>	
<b>Residency Requirement</b>	
<p>New York City residency is generally required within 90 days of appointment. However, City Employees in certain titles who have worked for the City for 2 continuous years may also be eligible to reside in Nassau, Suffolk, Putnam, Westchester, Rockland, or Orange County.
