<p>The New York City Department of Correction (DOC) provides for the care, custody, and control of persons accused of crimes or convicted and sentenced to one year or less of jail time. The Department manages 12 inmate facilities, 9 of which are located on Rikers Island. In addition, the Department operates two hospital Prison Wards (Bellevue and Elmhurst hospitals) and court holding facilities in each borough.</p> <p>The DOC is seeking H.V.A.C Technicians who's task will include but are not limited to the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Refrigeration mechanic repairs, clean, test, inspect and maintains refrigeration systems. • Installs and repairs refrigeration systems in commercial buildings, residential homes and health facilities. • Reviews blueprints & able to follow wiring diagrams. • Recovers and properly dispose of refrigerants when servicing air conditionings. • Repairs & maintains gas fired heating units. • Records data & maintain maintenance log book daily, submits reports when inspecting systems, such as temperature of equipment, refrigerant pressures etc. • Solders and brazes refrigeration piping. • Performs preventive/corrective maintenance to a wide variety of HVAC equipment. • Some physical activities including loading and unloading light utility trucks, lift equipment up to 75 pounds. Lifting equipment overhead, climbing and descending ladders, working on height up to 50 feet, crouching to reach equipment being repaired or installed.

<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Five years of full-time satisfactory experience acquired within the last 15 years as a Steam Fitter; or 2. Not less than two and one-half years of such experience acquired within the last 10 years plus sufficient full-time experience as a helper or apprentice to make up a total of five years of acceptable experience. Six months of experience will be credited for each year of apprenticeship or helper experience or for each year of completed approved trade or vocational school training in the steam fitting field. <p>*EPA 608 certification: Type II or III or Universal</p>
