




Project # SANDTWOBR | Borough: Manhattan | Date Issued: 04/19/2024 The Brooklyn Bridge – Montgomery Coastal Resilience (BMCR) Project is an initiative to provide long-term flood protection on the south side of Manhattan.

Closure Under FDR at South Street and Pier 35 Starting April 19, 2024, and ongoing until further notice

To access Pier 35, pedestrians should use the waterfront pathway from Rutgers Slip or the waterfront pathway from Pier 36. New barriers installed near Pier 35 to discourage midblock crossing. There is no direct access to Pier 35 from South Street.

To access the waterfront from South St., use crosswalks at the intersections Montgomery St., Rutgers Slip, Pike Slip, Market Slip, or Catherine Slip.
