Other type of income includes employment, own business, social security benefits, survivors insurance, supplemental security income, benefits from public & non-public funds and assets, unemployment insurance, federal wages, housing authority wages, military wages, pension, child support and alimony.
36. **Number of Families with 1 or More Employed:** A family where at least the head of household and/or family member receives income from employment and/or own business and/or unemployment insurance and/or federal wages and/or housing authority wages and/or military wages regardless of receiving any other type of income.
37. **As Percent of All Families:** Number of families with 1 or more employed divided by total number of families.
38. **With Adult as Secondary Wage Earner:** A family having at least 2 membersⁿ with Working Income if the “Head Income Source” and/or “Member Income Source”. Working Income includes employment, own business, unemployment insurance, federal wages, housing authority wages and military wages regardless of receiving any other type of income.
39. **Average Number of Years in Public Housing:** Mean of the sum of the difference between January 1, 2015 and date of admission for each household.
40. **Number of Years Development in Full Operation:** Year difference of January 1, 2015 minus the date of occupation completed. This figure is rounded to one decimal place and it is only done at development level
41. **Population by Age Group – Under Age 4:** Number of residents under age 4.
42. **Population by Age Group – Age 4 to 5:** Number of residents between age 4 and 5.
43. **Population by Age Group – Age 6 to 9:** Number of residents between age 6 and 9.
44. **Population by Age Group – Age 10 to 13:** Number of residents between age 10 and 13.
45. **Population by Age Group – Age 14 to 17:** Number of residents between age 14 and 17.
46. **Population by Age Group – Age 18 to 20:** Number of residents between age 18 and 20.
47. **Population by Age Group – Age 21 to 49:** Number of residents between age 21 and 49.
48. **Population by Age Group – Age 50 to 61:** Number of residents between age 50 and 61.
49. **Population by Age Group – Age 62 Plus:** Number of residents age 62 and over.
