TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT AGENT KALYANARATNE RANASINGHE Manhattan Summons Enforcement Section



On Saturday, November 30, 2013, Traffic Enforcement Agent Kalyanaratne Ranasinghe was struck and killed by a vehicle in a line of duty traffic accident.

Agent Ranasinghe was assigned to a post which included East 44th Street, near Fifth Avenue, in the Midtown section of Manhattan.

At approximately 2:30 pm, while initiating traffic enforcement action, Agent Ranasinghe was struck by a commercial vacuum truck traveling forward from a standing position at the curbline and pinned beneath the vehicle.

Agent Ranasinghe sustained fatal injuries and did not survive.

Traffic Enforcement Agent Level II Kalyanaratne Ranasinghe joined the New York City Police Department in December 2006 and served for nearly 7 years. He was almost 72 years of age. Agent Ranasinghe was survived by his wife, Dammika and daughter, Dimuthu.
