Stay Safe from Sex Trafficking

You have the right to be in control of your body.

- No one should ask you to engage in any sexual acts in exchange for housing, employment, money, safety, or to pay back a debt.
- No one should ask you to engage in any sexual acts by threatening or hurting you, your family, or your friends. This includes threats of deportation or taking your children away.
- No one should ask you to perform any sexual acts by withholding your ID, passport, or other documents.
- No one should limit your movement or ability to leave a location, such as your home or a job site.
- No one should keep track of where you go or confine you.
- No one should keep you from seeing or talking to your family or friends freely.
