



2016 NYC Employee Free Flu Vaccination Campaign

Every year, more than 2,000 New Yorkers die of seasonal influenza. A flu vaccination is the best preventative measure that can be taken to safeguard against this harmful virus. The Mayor's Office of Labor Relations is hosting its 3rd annual city-wide flu campaign, providing municipal employees, pre-Medicare retirees, and dependents with **free** flu vaccinations.

This year's campaign will be held from **Monday, September 12th, 2016** through **Wednesday, November 23rd, 2016**. There are four convenient ways to get vaccinated:

1. **Worksite Vaccination Program** (non-Medicare city employees only)
 - Worksite clinics will be scheduled at eligible participating agencies.
 - **ALL** employees, regardless of insurance provider, can get free flu shots at the workplace.
 - Appointments can be reserved at www.apschedule.com/nycflu (username: nyc, password: flushot) or by calling 866-481-4391, Mon-Fri from 8AM-6PM.
2. **Participating Pharmacies** (employees, dependents, and pre-Medicare retirees)
 - Walk into any participating pharmacy to receive a free flu shot. Check with your insurance provider to identify a participating pharmacy in your area and bring your insurance card to the pharmacy. You can use the NYC flu locator to find a pharmacy at www.nyc.gov/flu.
3. **In-Network Physicians** (employees, dependents, and pre-Medicare retirees)
 - Visit an in-network physician for your flu shot. The visit co-pay will be waived when the sole purpose of going to the doctor is to get your flu vaccine. Contact your insurance provider for more information. To find a physician covered by your insurance, visit zocdoc.com/nyc.
4. **AdvantageCare Physicians (ACPNY) Locations** (employees, dependents, and pre-Medicare retirees)
 - Flu shots will be available by walk-in or appointment at the new ACPNY Express for city employees, located near City Hall at 52 Duane St.
 - **ALL** employees, regardless of insurance provider, can get free flu shots at any ACPNY office.
 - ACPNY locations will also provide no cost immunizations to dependents (including pregnant women and children under 18 years old), pre-Medicare retirees, and spouses/dependents of pre-Medicare retirees. High-dose vaccines will be available for those 65 years and older.
 - Flu shots for all ACPNY locations can be scheduled at www.acpny.com or by calling the exclusive Gold Service Line for City of New York employees at 646-680-3000, Mon-Thurs from 8AM-8PM, Fri 8AM-5PM, or Sat 9AM-1:30PM.
