**2. Borough Totals for Community Districts**

The sum of Community Districts will not add to either borough or citywide totals. Manhattan's northernmost census tract 309 is physically on the Bronx mainland and is part of Bronx Community District 8. Riker's Island, Bronx census tract 1, is linked to Queens via a bridge and is tabulated as part of Queens Community District 1.
