As part of OneNYC the City is advancing sustainability initiatives to help make New York City a global leader in the fight against climate change. A key goal in OneNYC is the commitment to achieve an 80 percent reduction in Green House Gas (GHG) Emissions by 2050.

Sector	GHG Reduction Focus
 Buildings	Improve the energy performance of existing buildings
 Transportation	Reduce miles driven and accelerate the transition to low-carbon vehicles
 Energy Supply	Maximize use of carbon-free generation to meet demand
 Waste	Target organics and other major sources of methane emissions

Progress since the release of OneNYC

- Since the launch of the plan in 2015 New York City:
- Released New York City's Roadmap to 80x50, strategies to achieve an 80 percent reduction in Green House Gas (GHG) Emissions by 2050
 - Expanded solar energy target to 1,000 MW by 2030
 - Now operating over 500 electric vehicles and will increase to almost 1,000 by end of 2017
 - Quadrupled solar energy citywide since 2013
