- 1. REVISION #1 – New ADA Ramp and Handrails**
A new ADA compliant pedestrian access ramp to the building entrance along 31st Street is added so that it coordinates with the library's new exterior check-in equipment.
- 2. REVISION #2 – New Book Drop**
New outside self-check in equipment and new book drop is added at the main building façade facing 31th Street to replace the existing book drop.
- 3. REVISION #3 – New Aluminum Framed Entry System**
A new entrance system at the library main entrance at 31st Street is necessitated by the reorientation of the new ADA ramp.
