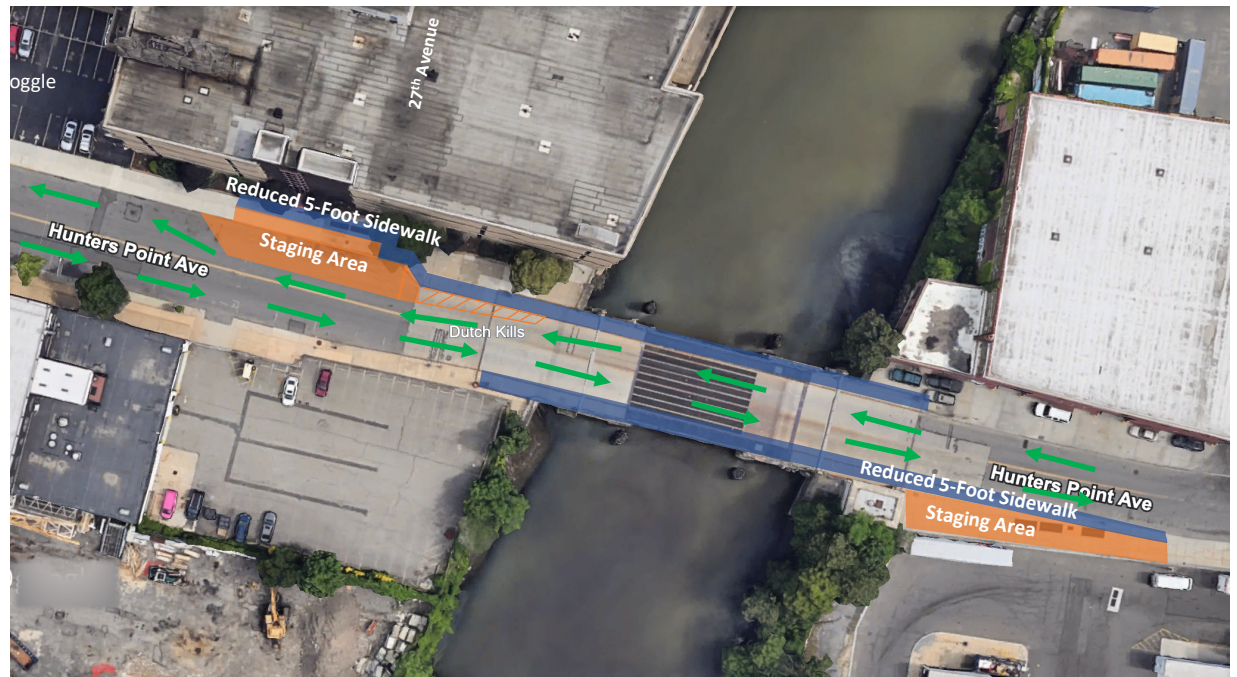

Important Notice

The NYCDOT Division of Bridges is mobilizing construction staging areas on the Hunters Point Bridge over Dutch Kills in Queens in preparation for lead paint removal and protective coating operations. Beginning on or about **February 19th**, **traffic will be shifted on Hunters Point Avenue** between 27th Street and 29th Avenue. One lane in each direction will be maintained at all times. Additionally, **the sidewalk on the northwest and southeast sides of the bridge will be reduced to 5 feet in width**. This traffic pattern will be in place 24/7 for approximately 6 weeks.

Beginning on or about Monday, February 19th for approximately 6 weeks
One lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained at all times
