DOT's Bikeshare Program is coming to our District

What is Citi Bike?

Citi Bike is the bike share system available in Manhattan, Brooklyn, Queens, and the Bronx. The system is run through a public-private partnership between New York City and Lyft. Citi Bike is a station-based bike share system. Riders unlock bikes from one station and return and lock the bike at any other station in the system, making bike share ideal for short, one-way trips.

As part of the process, **New York City Department of Transportation** provides the opportunity for those who may not be able to attend a public meeting to give feedback through a feedback portal where people can comment on where they would like to see Citi Bike stations, as well as locations not suitable for a station.


This process involves holding community planning workshops and meeting with Community Boards, elected officials, and community stakeholders to gather input.



Over the next few weeks, **Queens Community Board 4** will be reviewing the plan as we actively seek public input in advance of our **June 13th Full Board meeting**.

¿Qué es Citi Bike?

Citi Bike es el sistema de bicicletas compartidas disponible en Manhattan, Brooklyn, Queens y el Bronx. El sistema se ejecuta a través de un sistema público-privado asociación entre la ciudad de Nueva York y Lyft. Citi Bike es una estación basada sistema de bicicletas compartidas. Los ciclistas desbloquean bicicletas de una estación y regresan y bloquear la bicicleta en cualquier otra estación del sistema, haciendo que la bicicleta sea compartida ideal para viajes cortos de ida.

Como parte del proceso, el **Departamento de Transporte de la Ciudad de Nueva York** proporciona la oportunidad para aquellos que no puedan asistir a una reunión pública para dar comentarios a través de un portal de comentarios donde las personas pueden comentar dónde les gustaría ver estaciones de Citi Bike, así como ubicaciones no adecuadas para una estación.

Este proceso implica la realización de talleres de planificación comunitaria y reunirse con juntas comunitarias, funcionarios electos y miembros de la comunidad para recopilar información.

En las próximas semanas, la **Junta Comunitaria 4 de Queens** revisará el plan a medida que buscamos activamente la opinión del público antes de nuestra reunión mensual el **13 de junio**.

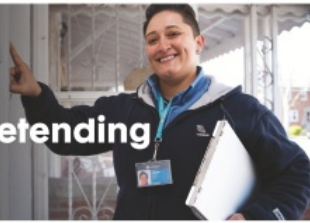

How to Recognize a Real Con Edison Employee

- Ask for ID. You're not being rude. You're being safe.
- Real Con Edison employees and contractors wear a photo ID badge with their name and employee number on it.
- They'll give you their supervisor's name, the unique "ticket" number assigned to your job, and ask you to call us at 1-800-75-CONED. They'll wait patiently while you check.
- Scammers may manipulate your caller I.D. to display our name. If in doubt, hang up and call 1-800-75-CONED (1-800-752-6633).

Don't fall for scams. Con Edison will NEVER:

- Threaten to turn off your electricity or gas without showing you identification.
- Demand immediate payment via a gift card, pre-paid debit card such as MoneyPak, cash app such as Zelle, or cryptocurrency such as bitcoin.
- Request a deposit or payment for a smart meter.
- Direct you to pay bills on any website other than: conEd.com, conEd.com/GuestPayment, or webpayments.billmatrix.com/ConEdResidential



The **Fire Cadet Academy** is designed to ensure that Cadets become familiar with the operations of the Fire Department and to provide leadership training. Cadets will receive significant classroom, field and fitness training over the course of the two (2) year program. Cadets will be required to attend the Fire Academy two (2) Saturdays per month to participate in classroom training, field training, and fitness conditioning.

Cadets will be assigned to work in major FDNY bureaus where they will receive hands-on training and learn how the bureaus relate to one another in order to provide optimal response to emergencies, as well as to enhance their ability to provide service in a number of capacities throughout the Agency. Cadets must be willing to commit to a minimum of 20 hours per week and can work up to 34 hours per week. Cadets will earn \$15.67 per hour.
