- 1. It was announced that the people who attend the Mosque on Richmond Terrace often park on the sidewalk and in other people's driveways.
- 2. There has been an ongoing problem with prostitution at 194 Park Ave. It is a vacant home. This was referred to NYPD Community Affairs.
- 3. There is also a problem with a home on Park Ave that has a lot of dogs.
- 4. It was announced that Robberies in Port Richmond are down 14%. In addition violent crime is down. An additional 35 officers have been placed in Mariner's Harbor due to an increase in crime in that area.
- 5. There is an empty lot on the corner of Maple/Grove Ave owned by Berksquare Realty.
  - a. What restrictions are on the lot?
  - b. How can the restrictions be enforced?
  - c. Why is the lot locked?

### **Transportation Concerns**

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- 6. Trucks traveling down Decker Ave continues to be a problem Refer to the Transportation Committee
- 7. There has been an increase in commercial traffic traveling up Park Ave between New St. and Castleton Ave. Refer to the Transportation Committee.
- 8. Residents requested a feasibility study for the intersection of New St. and Park Ave
  - a. 4 Way Stop Sign
  - b. It is also difficult to make turns off Park Ave onto Castleton Ave due to the view being obstructed.
- 9. A request was made for additional parking for Commercial Vehicles making deliveries at Broadway / Castleton Ave. Or change the existing parking to "Back-In" only parking.
- 10. A question was asked why DOT has installed "No Parking" around Maple Ave/Grove Ave/Port Richmond Ave.
- 11. Atlantic Express Buses continue to traveling down Faber St, Grove Ave, and Maple Aves.
