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Dear Dr. Young and Mr. Sweeney:

With this letter, I am submitting the following deliverable, due June 30, 2015, pursuant to the NYSDOH Revised 2007 Filtration Avoidance Determination (FAD):

<i>Program</i>	<i>Deliverable</i>
<i>4.9 East of Hudson Non-point Source Pollution Control Program - Septic Repair Program Strategy (SRP)</i>	Proposal to expand the SRP to the Croton Falls and Cross River Reservoir basins.

The Community Wastewater Management Program, section 3.3 required the Community Wastewater Management Program study phase, for Shandaken and West Conesville, be completed by June 30, 2015. The participating communities took additional time before they signed the required agreements with the Catskill Watershed Corporation. Those agreements were signed on November 17, 2014 and January 7, 2015, respectively. Usually, the study phase takes approximately one year to complete. Therefore, CWC anticipates completion of the studies by December 31, 2015.

The East of Hudson Non-point Source Pollution Control Program - Septic Repair Program Strategy, section 4.9 required implementation of the West Branch/Boyd Corners Septic Repair Program to commence by June 30, 2015. All required contractual mechanisms were in place with NYS EFC by May 1, 2015. Since then, DEP has notified the Town Supervisors of the municipalities within the program area and has also conducted outreach to the Putnam and Dutchess County Health Departments. EFC anticipates mailing letters to residents by June 30, 2015.
