Obtain and advance the support of New York City, it's agencies, departments, commissions and public authorities/corporations -- including the Mayor's Office, the various Deputy Mayors, Transportation, Parks, City Planning Departments, DDC, EDC, HPD, SBS, Local Community Boards and the MTA -- for approvals and implementation of an ambitious revisioning, urban redesign and redevelopment plan for the research, natural and cultural district of the north central Bronx, located around Bronx Park and the Moshulu. The major focus during this reporting period was to advance the conversation with respect on how to trigger and advance redevelopment opportunities along Webster Avenue, now that the mixed use re-zoning has been approved. The discussion focused on potential redevelopment strategies and mechanisms that might be employed to advance and jumpstart this effort, including a meeting for stakeholders.

Advance proposal to maintain the major portion Fordham's Rose Hill Campus Bronx Zoning Lot as an R-6 Zone and exempt from inclusion in a downzoning to an R-6B zone, as part of an adjunct to the overall Fordham Road Rezoning effort. A portion of the campus zoning lot was being earmarked for a new Science Building, and was inadvertently included in a proposal to downzone a residential off-campus street, in a way that would prohibit the development of such a building. Already obtained approval of the Department of City Planning for modification of the rezoning proposal, subject to the concurrence of Bronx Community Board 6, which is the focus of the current activities. The Bronx Community Board on the recommendation of its Housing and Land Use Committee approved the exemption or carve-out of this parcel from the down-zoning area on 9 May 2012
