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Subject Details

Sought the introduction of bills that would:

- 1) curb further the outlay of public funds to candidates facing minimal opposition_
- 2) establish a more stringent "war chest" restriction to limit the transfer of funds raised in one race for use in another_
- 3) close the run-off loophole that allows candidates to keep unused public funds granted at a rate of 1/4 of the primary money raised_
- 4) require all poll workers to attend training before each election cycle, including returning poll workers_
- 5) Enforce a policy to ban poll worker trainees who failed the poll worker test after training from serving at the polls that year_
- 6) Require coordinators to contact poll site personnel prior to Election Day to ensure near 100% attendance
- 7) Email notification of election dates, deadlines, and ballots to registered voters
- 8) Provide sample ballots online
- 9) Direct city agencies to fully comply with the mandates of NVRA and the City's Pro-Voter law
- 10) Encourage city employees to register as poll workers by printing information on paychecks or other notices
- 11) Limit stipend allocations for committee chairs and leadership positions
- 12) Create stronger and more independent council committees by empowering all committee chairs to set their own agendas, schedule votes, and participate in the hiring and firing decisions for committee staff_ and
- 13) Ensure a more equitable distribution of council resources to each council member and their respective district that is not based on political considerations.
