<p>Description: Adjournment in Contemplation of Dismissal/ Conditional Discharge</p> <p>Average Duration: 6 mos/1 yr</p> <p>Capacity: N/A</p>	<p>Description: Contact: 1 mtg per mo. for 1st 6 mo. plus referral to services as needed. Also 2 collateral and phone contacts per quarter. Home contacts as needed.</p> <p>Average Duration: 1 year or less</p> <p>Capacity: TBD</p>	<p>Description: Contact: 2 mtgs per mo. plus referral to services as needed. 6 add'l contacts per quarter (phone and field visits regarding case plan), including at least 1 home visit.</p> <p>Average Duration: 1 year</p> <p>Capacity: TBD</p>	<p>Description: Contact: Begins with 6 personal contacts and 8 collateral contacts per month. Contact levels gradually decrease over time. Followed by level of probation to be determined via assessment during transitional planning phase prior to completing AIM</p> <p>Average Duration: 4-6 months in AIM, 6-18 on probation</p> <p>Capacity: 50 slots</p>	<p>Description: Highly intensive level of probation (5 weekly contacts including Saturday work group; life coaching model) focused explicitly on promoting change in its participants so that they can fully participate in society and can forge a successful transition into adulthood</p> <p>Average Duration: 1 year</p> <p>Capacity: 70 slots</p>	<p>Description: In-home, evidence-based treatment modalities, including Functional Family Therapy, Multi-dimensional Treatment Foster Care & Multi Systemic Therapy, followed by level of probation to be determined via assessment during transitional planning phase prior to completion of JJI</p> <p>Average Duration: 6-12 months in JJI, 6-18 months probation</p> <p>Capacity: 200 slots</p>	<p>Description: Residential facilities for youth who have been placed into the custody of ACS by a Family Court judge as a disposition of their juvenile delinquency case. Services include youth care, education, social work and case management services, social skills instruction, access to mental health and substance abuse treatment, coordination of health care, and public safety measures.</p>
