



CAPS Online will launch on September 1, 2021

How can I prepare now for CAPS Online?

Register now for Training: Register online at <https://earlychildhoodny.org/capsonline/>. All child care programs and providers are urged to register early for training. The earlier you sign up for training, the easier it will be to pick a time that works for you. Training will be available in English and Spanish. Topics covered in trainings include creating a NYC ID which providers will use to access CAPS Online.

Update your browser: To access CAPS Online, you must use one of the latest versions of Edge, Chrome, Firefox, Safari or Internet Explorer 11.

Set up your NYC ID: You can now log onto CAPS Online at <https://a069-capsonline.nyc.gov> and set up your profile and NYC ID. A video guide on how to do this can be found at <https://earlychildhoodny.org/capsonline/>. *Please note that while you can log into CAPS Online before September 1, you will not be able to enter daily time-in time-out attendance until Wednesday, September 1, 2021.*

Why should I attend a training?

The CAPS Online training is optional, but is Quality Assured in the Aspire Registry, and is an OCFS-approved training. The training will provide 1 hour of professional development in Core Competency Area 7 (Administration and Management) or OCFS Training Topic 5 (Business record maintenance and management).

Trainings cover topics such as:

- Creating an NYC ID to access CAPS Online
- Tracking current attendance
- Using the placement roster
