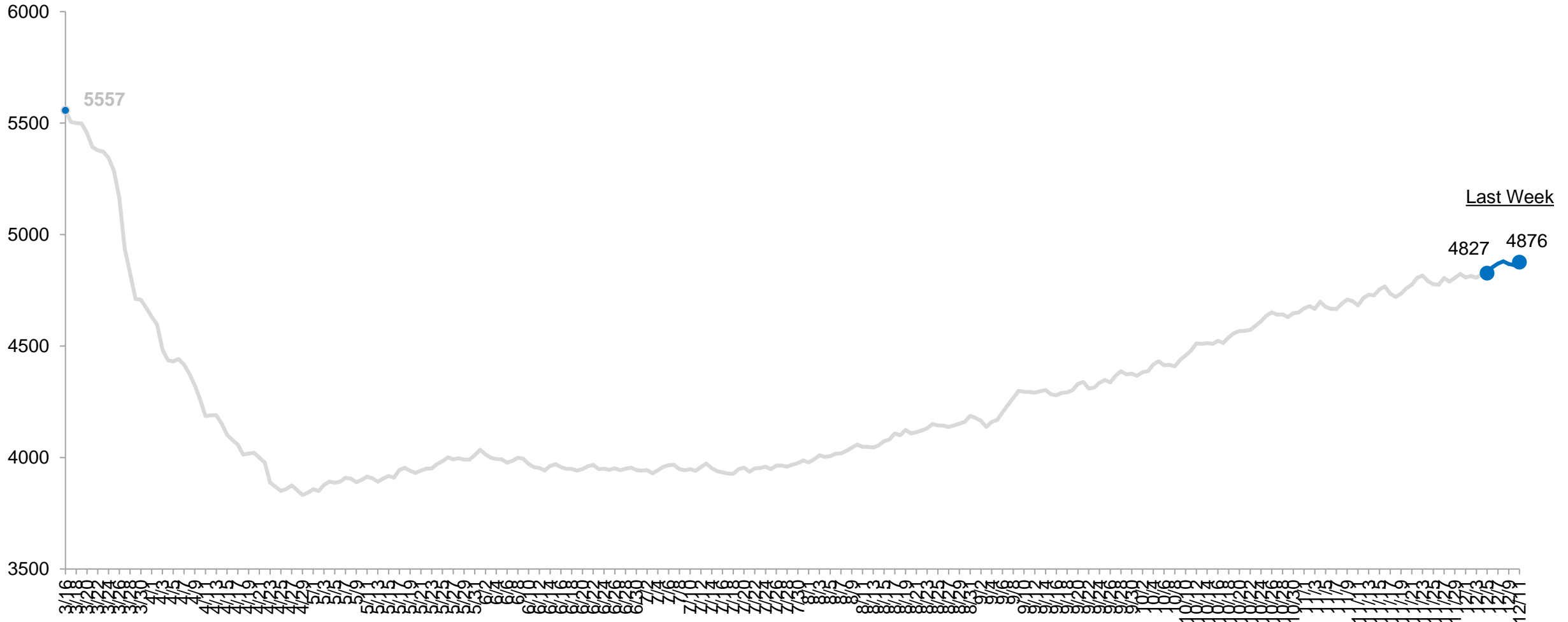

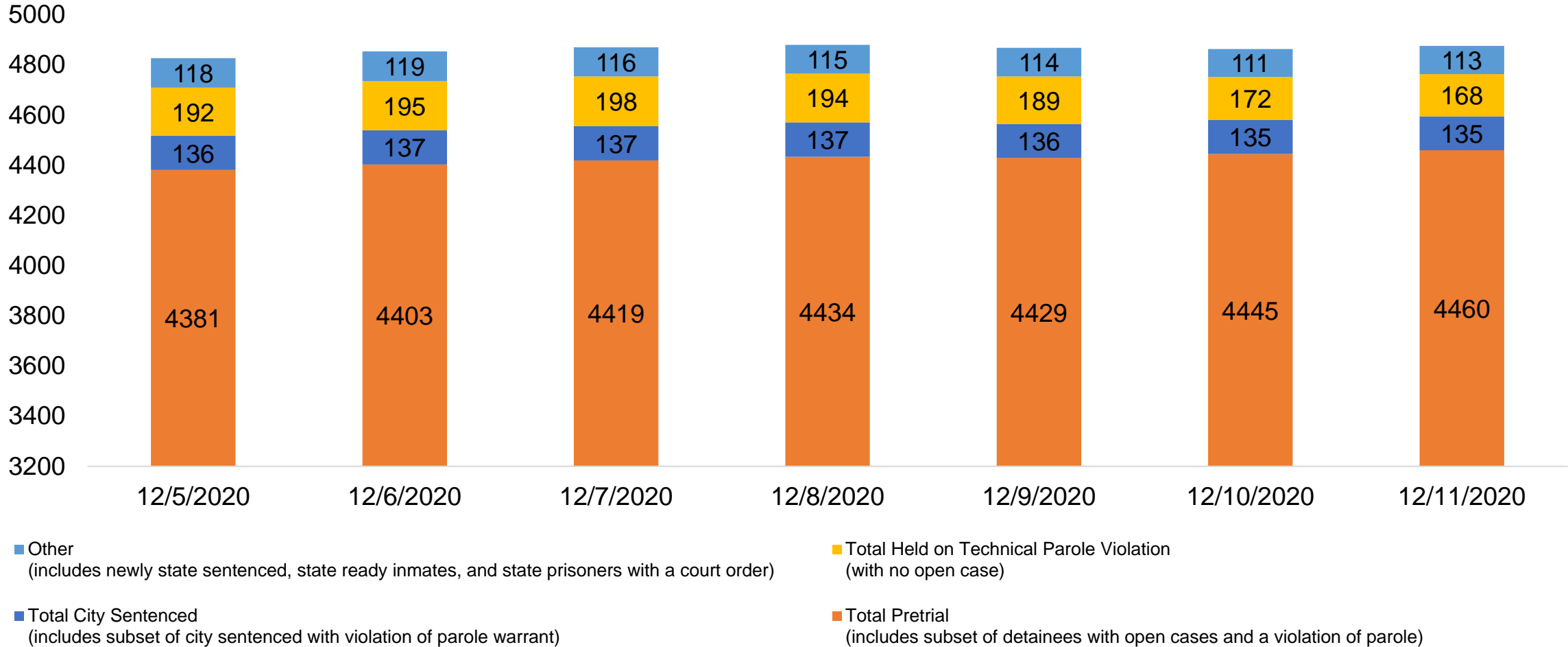
Total Population in DOC Custody March 16 – December 11, 2020

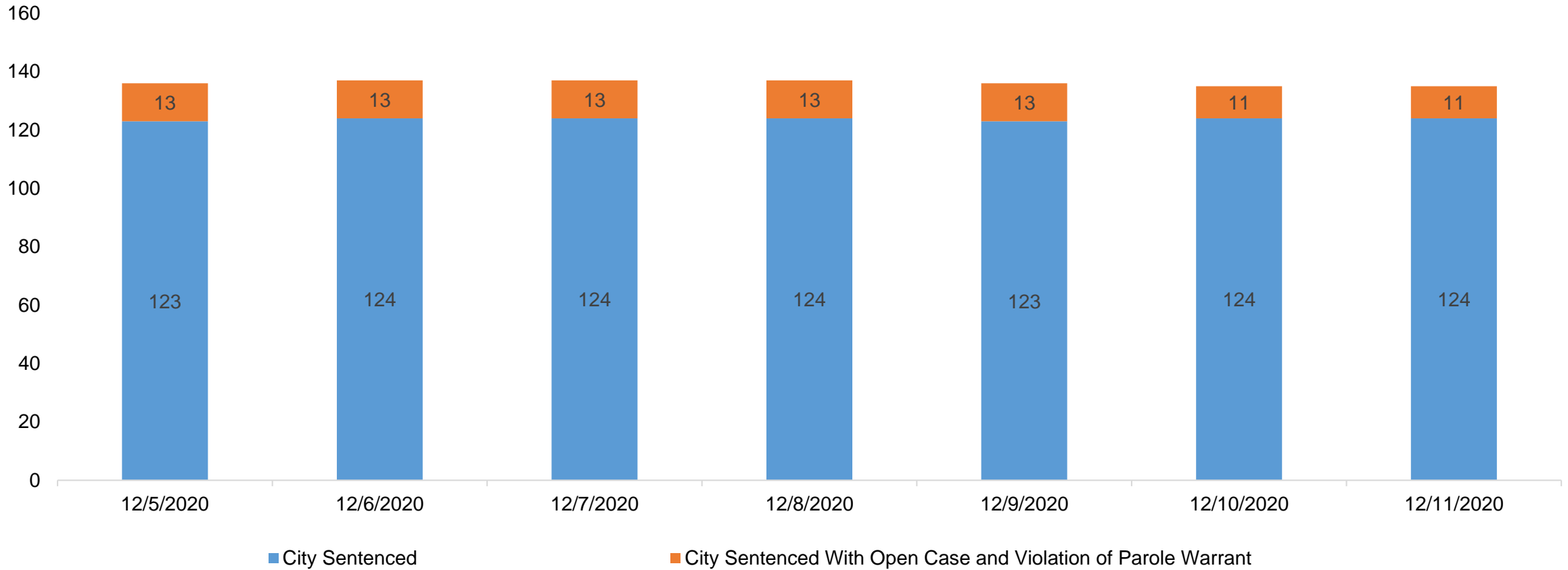

Total DOC Population by Custody Status, 12/05/2020-12/11/2020



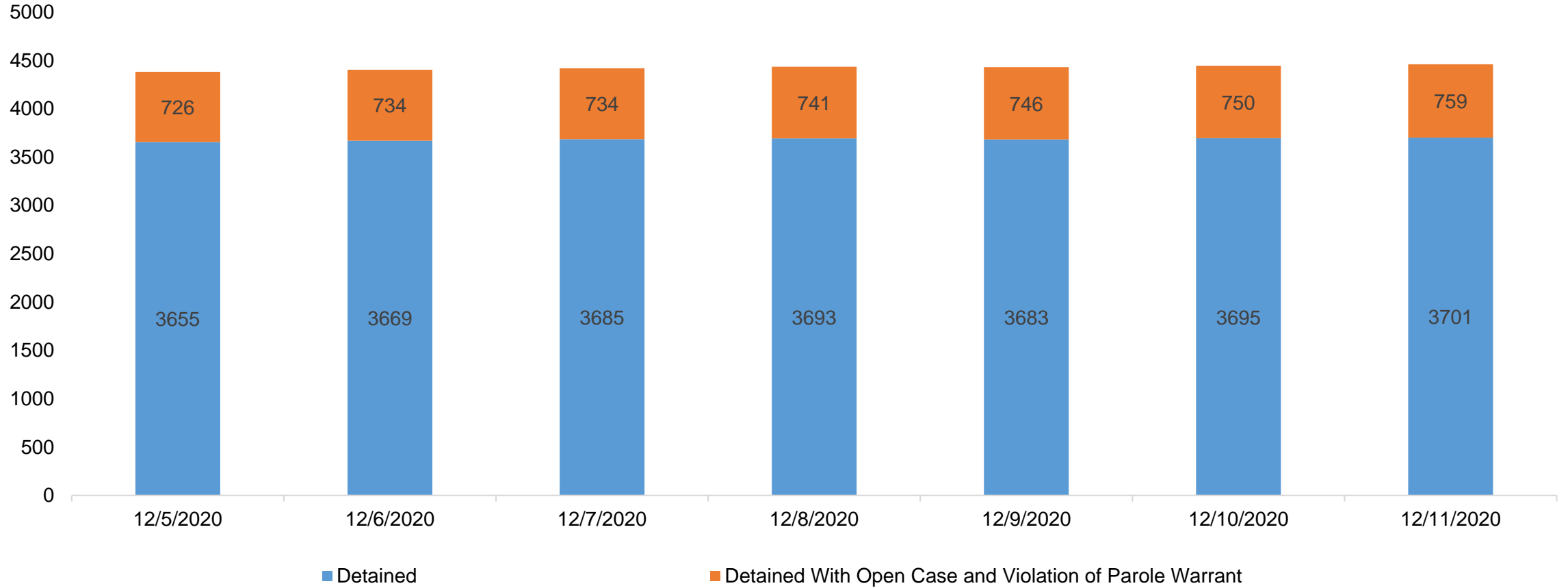

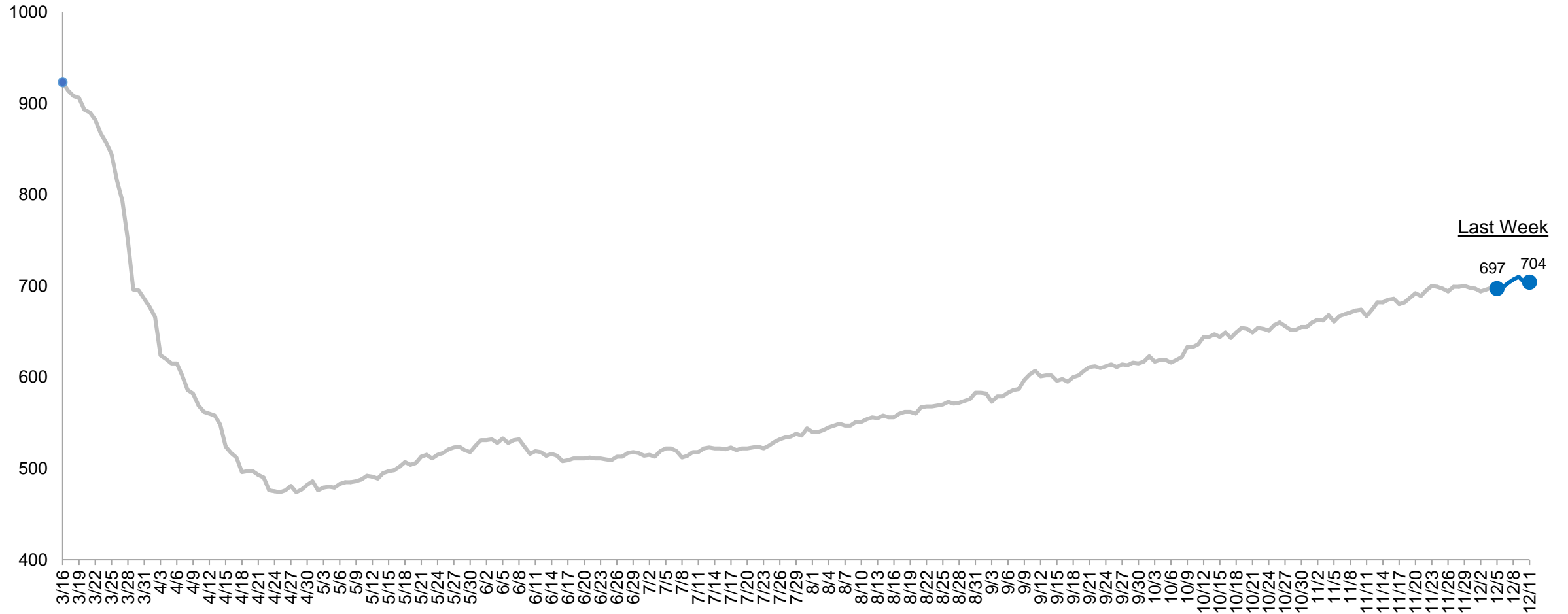

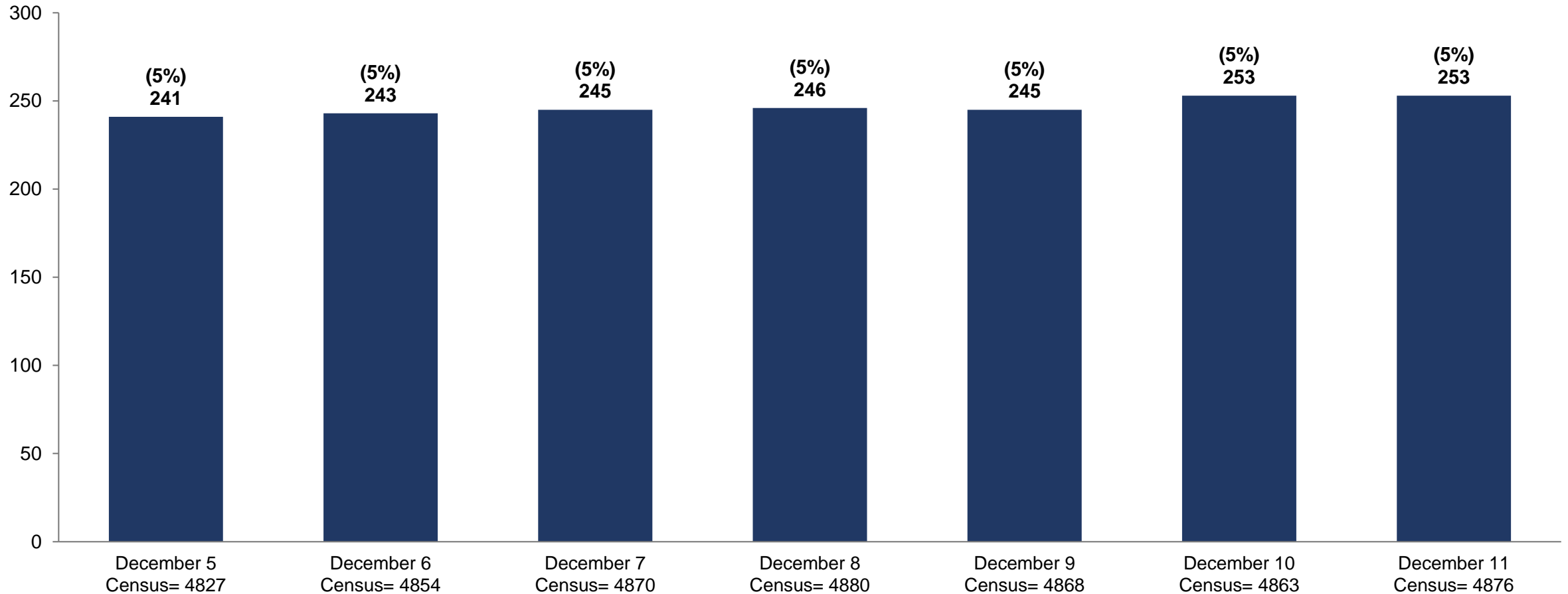

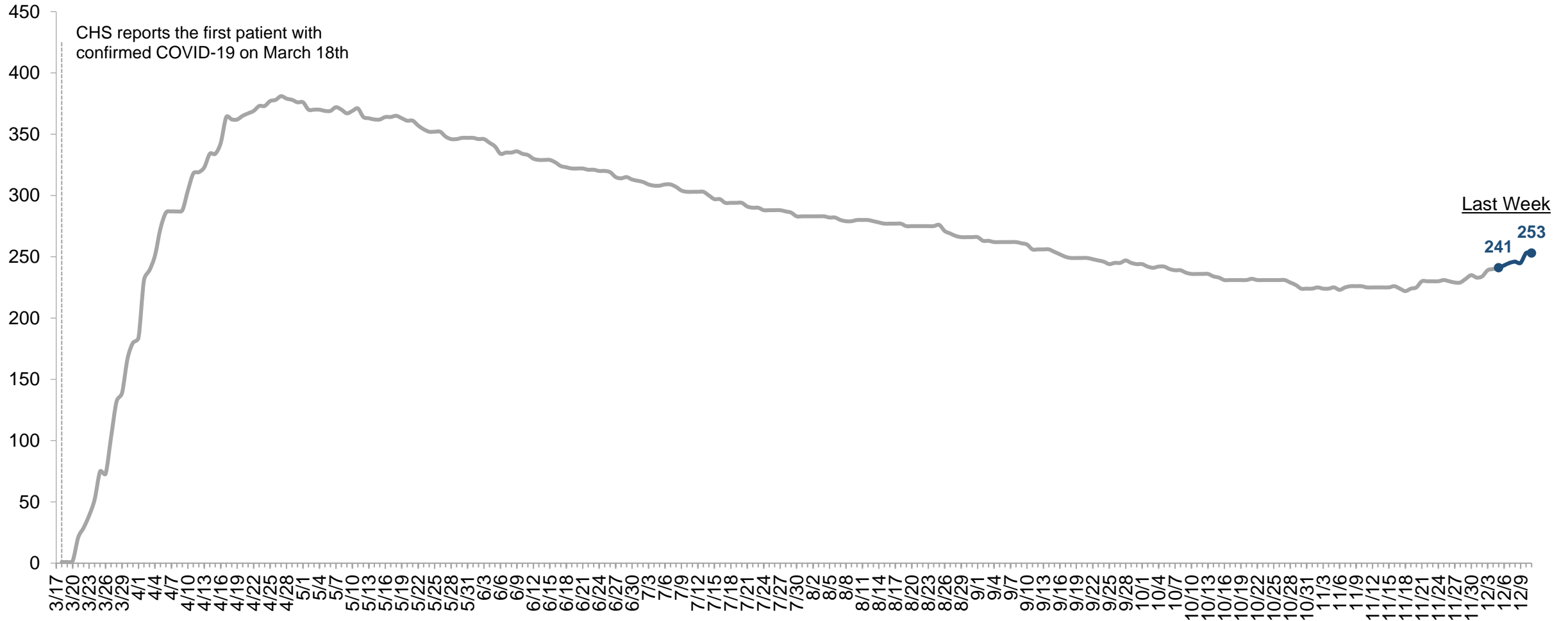
Number and Percent of Patients with Confirmed COVID-19

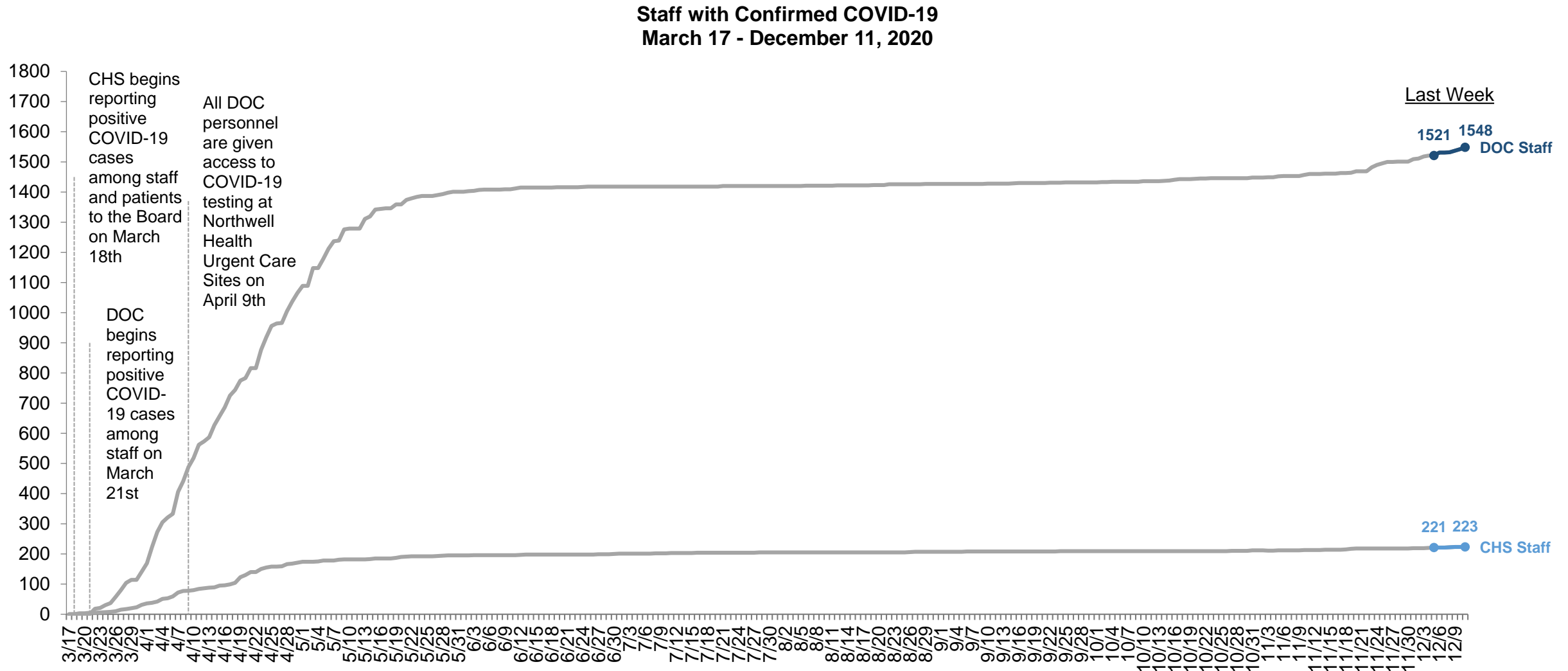

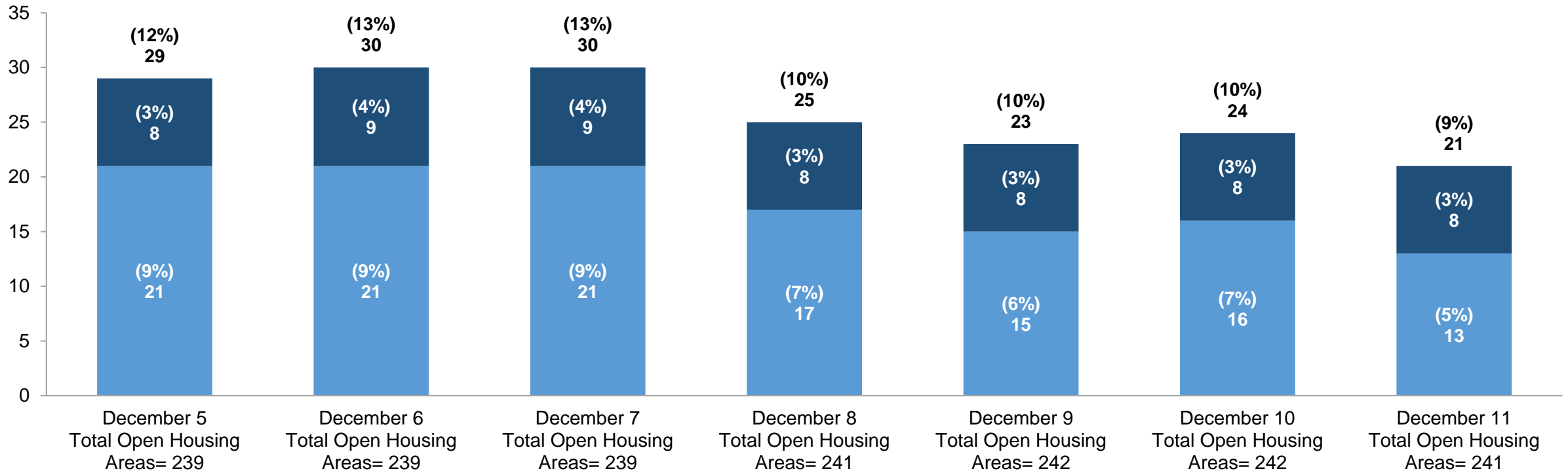

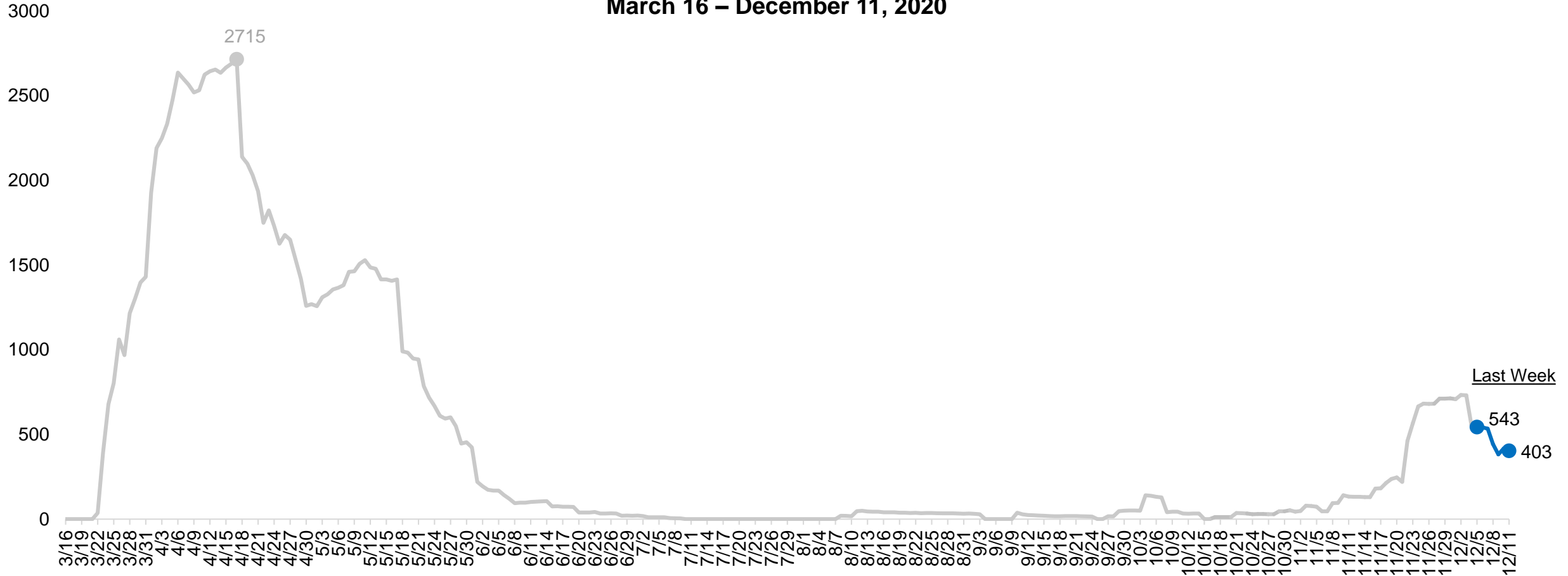

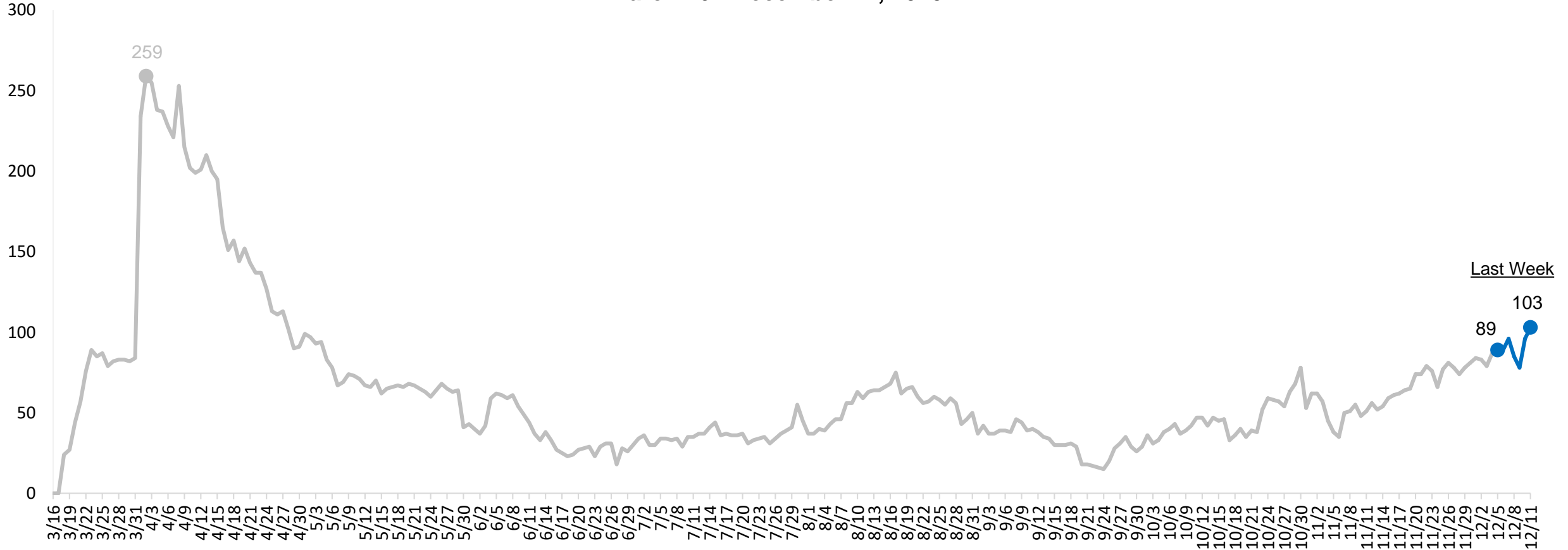

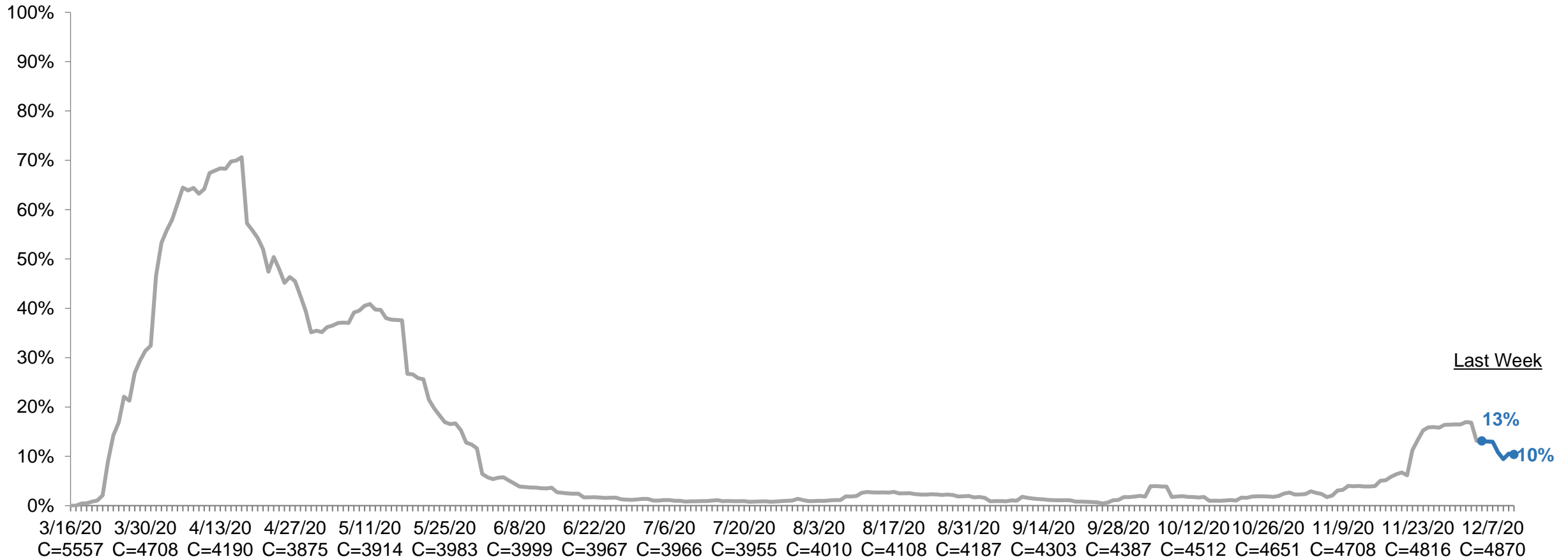

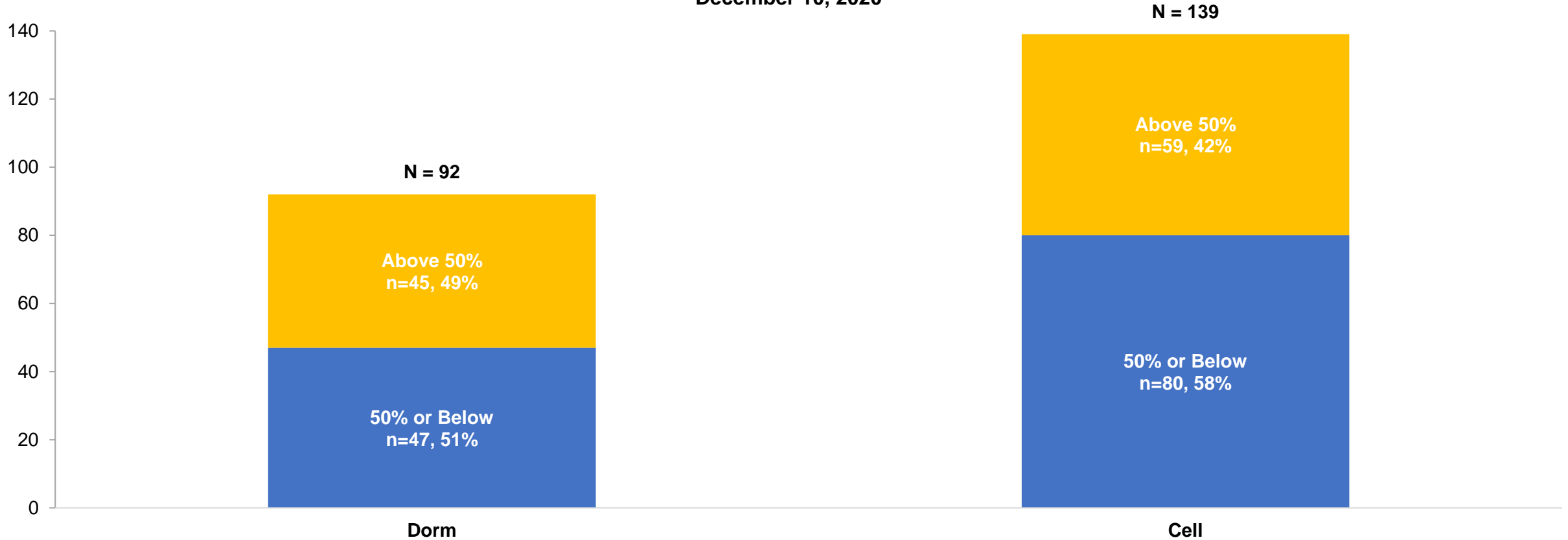

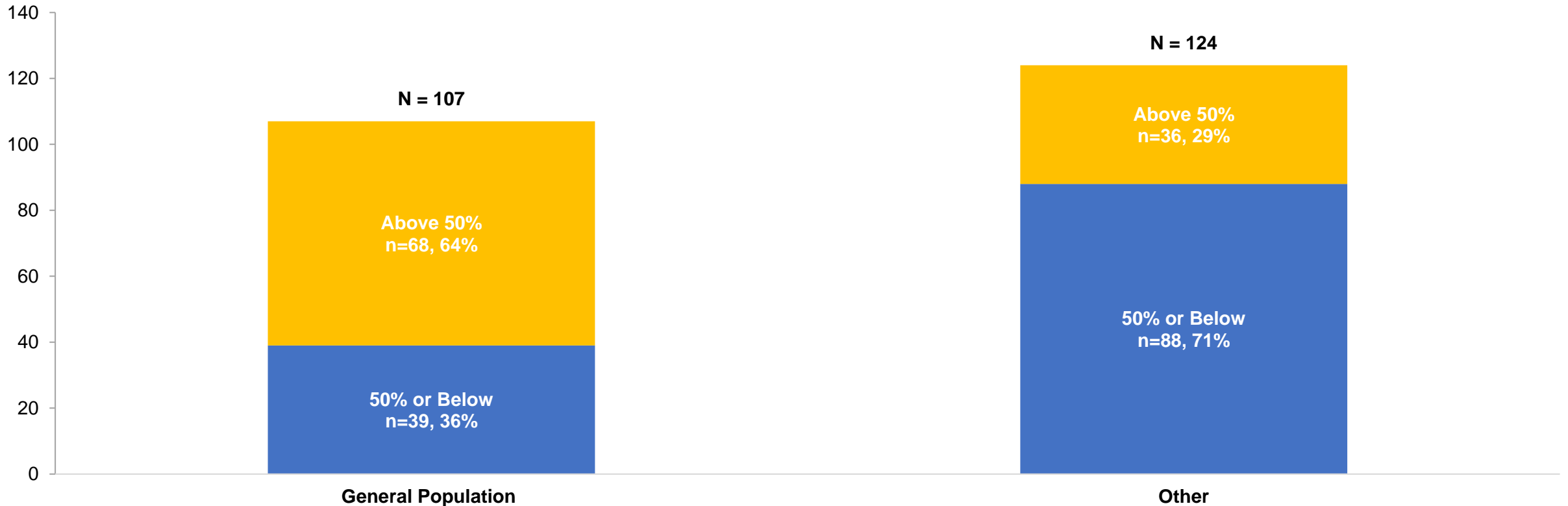

December 10, 2020



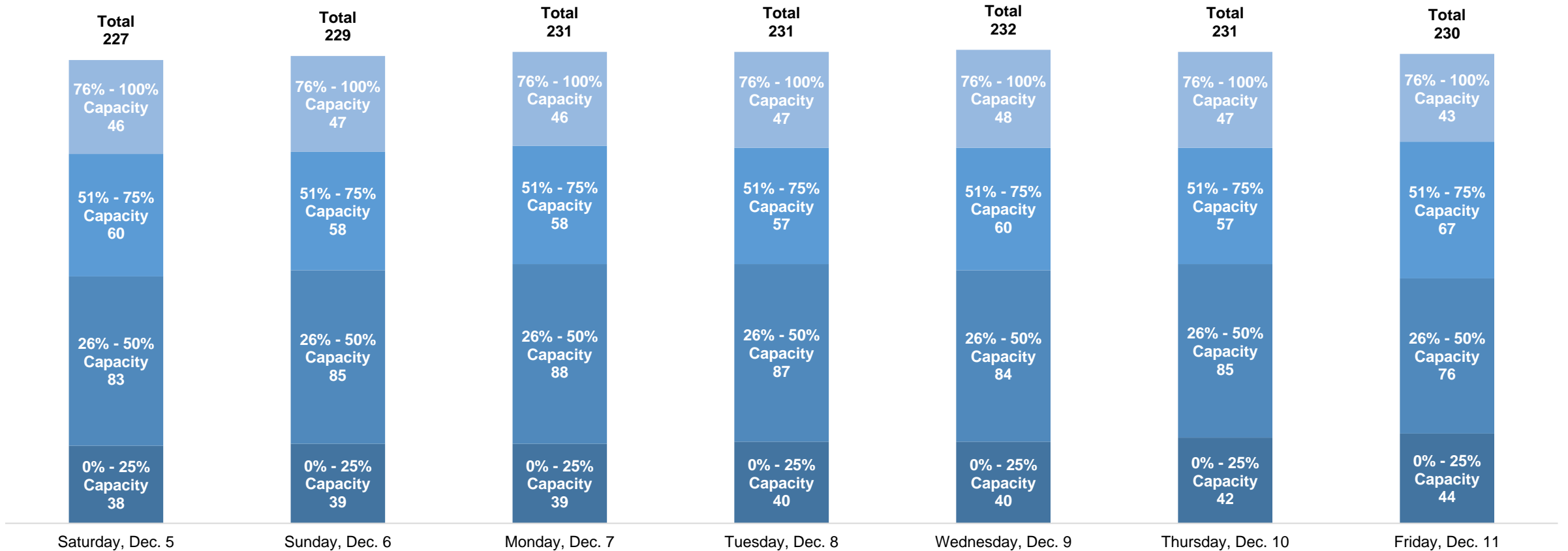
