Days are only added to each Young Adult's cumulative level total if the stay in a given level has concluded. For example, if at the time of reporting a Young Adult is currently on his 10th day in Level 1 after spending 30 days in ESH Entry, only the 30-day stay in the Entry Unit is included in the Young Adult's record, as the stay in Level 1 is active as of the reporting period close. Records are only included for Young Adults placed in ESH after March 1, 2017, upon the formalization of the Entry Unit.
