Youth and Education Committee minutes rev. April 23, 2018

Nicholas Sala has not attended any of the committees' last four meetings and as such will be removed from our roster.

We had as our guest Jorge Luis Paniagua Valle, chief of staff, of the non-profit organization "The Mayor's Fund to Advance NYC."

Through private/public partnerships they are looking to build a soccer field at MS180 middle school at 700 Baychester Avenue. The field will support programs for youth soccer which will have both health and social benefits. We suggested that they reach out to Montefiore/ Mosholu community organization as they currently are contracted by DYCD to run a youth program in the area.

The US Soccer Foundation, New York City Football Club, Adidas, and Etihad Airways are the private partners who will be working with NYC DOE, Parks, and NYCHA as the public partners. The goal is 50 fields in 5 years in the 5 boroughs. Each site will have a program of 75-90 minutes three days a week at a minimum for middle and grammar school students. There are still opportunities to suggest sites.

A motion was made by Joseph Onwu and seconded by Stephanie Woods to vote on the following resolution:

"Resolved...at the recommendation of the Youth and Education Committee of Bronx Community Board #10, to send a letter of support (see attached draft) to the Mayor's Fund to Advance NYC, and that the resolution be forwarded to the full board for approval."

The vote was unanimously in support.

The Committee discussed the internship program and how we will go about reaching out to merchants. (See attached letter)

The nominations for Chair of the Youth and Education Committee were opened and Joseph Onwu nominated Robert Bieder, and second was made by Stephanie Woods. There were no other nominations and the vote was unanimous. Nominations for Co-Chair were then opened and Lauren Council was nominated by Stephanie Woods and Seconded by Michelle Davilla. There being no other nominations the nominations were closed and the vote was unanimous.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:30

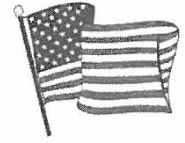
